

Dear Prospective M Tech (EE) student,

You must have already received the email from the IISC Admissions Unit, asking you to come to IISc on Monday, April 17th, to take your test and interview for possible admission to the M Tech (EE) program in our Department. I would like to give you some clarity about the logistics of the selection process.

As far as our Department is concerned, all the students who have been shortlisted based on their GATE score, will both write the technical test and be interviewed. The final selection is based on the combined performance.

The interviews will start around 9.30 am in our Dept. after your briefing by the Admissions unit. Those of you, who have applied for M Tech in DESE will be writing your test for the same from 9 to 10.30 am. Others may report to Dept. of Electrical Engineering for the interview. Those of you, who have applied for M Tech in CDS will be writing their entrance test from 11.30 am and the EE interviews will continue for the rest in the Dept. of Electrical Engineering.

All applicants called for our Dept. will write the test for 90 minutes from 2 pm to 3.30 pm in the II Floor of our Dept. in hall numbers B304, B306 and B308. The syllabus is the same as that for the GATE paper for EE. After the test, one of the faculty members will address you in hall No. B308 for about 15 minutes, after which the technical interviews will continue.

Interviews will be conducted by three parallel committees in Room No.s A105, C123 and B218, on April 17 and 18. We would like to preferably interview as many outstation candidates as possible on April 17. However, some may need to be interviewed on 18th and we advise you to come prepared for that. Room No. A104 will be available for you while waiting for your turn to be interviewed.

On the afternoon of April 17 and the forenoon of April 18, the current M Tech students of our department will be displaying posters of their projects in the foyer of the department. You are invited to visit the posters to get familiar with the kind of research and development work being carried out in the Department and also interact with the current students.
